Do remember that this camera is not a speed camera which can issue fines. All the speeding vehicles have to be cross-checked by volunteers from the Parish before any information is sent on to the Police. This is a time- consuming job and more volunteers are always welcome.

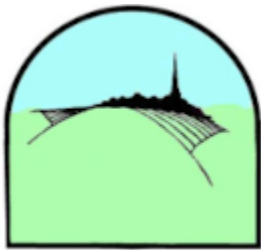
Our numbers are increasing on the Parish Council. We are delighted to welcome **Jade Hill** as the latest to join our ranks. There is still one space available.....
